- <u>'Kids on the Block'</u>: disability awareness and anti-bullying presentation for K-Gr3.

  Colleen purchases (using school funds) 2 bags of apples every 2 weeks. These are available, in the office, to any student in the school, along with non-perishable supplies in the food cupboard. Colleen will approach Sobeys to ask if they would consider a donation.
