- Rain barrel fundraiser: Sold 54 barrels & 8 tanks, as of Thursday. Barrels to arrive on Friday morning (5<sup>th</sup> May) to be stored at Outdoor Rink overnight. Distribution from 2pm-5pm on Saturday. Creann to arrange for a photograph for the West Carleton review.

- Jay & Colleen both definitely returning next year.
- Lots of Spring events report from Donna Coutts.
- Staffing still not finalised. Have no vacancies & no surplus teachers, despite enrollment slightly down. All contract teachers & ECE's returning. No news yet about EA's. Classroom teacher assignments available on first year of school. Hoping for a few more enrollments for JK.
- Still on track with budget. Hoping to finish the year under budget.
- The school does get an HST rebate. Bought sports equipment; new core french resources; new novel sets Gr7&8 book clubs; social studies resources; 5 new Chromebooks (to replace 5 laptops so they can be used with Lego Robotics sets for Gr7 & 8); supplemented \$1k given by Gr8 grads giving a water fountain as a legacy gift; Red maple tree to go out front by bench.
